Subject: Host City Games Accessibility Commitment

Dear General Managers:

The Los Angeles 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games are an opportunity for the City of Los Angeles and partner agencies to welcome the world in the celebration of sport and humanity, and to provide a lasting positive legacy for residents of the region. The City of Los Angeles is committed to the proposition that all people, including people with disabilities, have the inherent right to participate equally, fully, and independently in this extraordinary experience, to be uplifted by it, and to benefit from all aspects of the Games' enduring legacy.

Therefore, the City of Los Angeles shall plan and implement the LA28 Games and their legacy infrastructure and programming according to the following vision and principles in order to deliver an accessible Los Angeles 2028 “Games For All” and provide a lasting legacy for Angelenos with disabilities.

Civil Rights & Equity

- People with disabilities will have equitable access to all Games related programs, services, activities, facilities, and information.
- The Olympics and Paralympics will be treated with equal importance and recognition.
- The City will engage other agencies involved in the delivery of the Games and work to ensure that they too are meeting applicable disabled access requirements, prioritizing equitable access to the Games and benefits of legacy projects.

Community Engagement

- Stakeholders with disabilities will be meaningfully engaged and provided the opportunity to have their input considered for incorporation into all relevant aspects of the City's Games-related planning and activities.

Resources & Integration

- All City departments, employees, and vendors responsible for planning and delivering the Games will understand and integrate applicable disability access and inclusion requirements and best practices into their work for the Games in order to achieve equity and maximize cost-effectiveness and efficiency.
- City agencies will allocate the resources necessary to train their staff, volunteers, and vendors to deliver Games that are accessible to and inclusive of people with disabilities.
- The City and partner agencies will communicate and collaborate to ensure a seamless accessible experience for stakeholders with disabilities.
